

BUSINESS MISSION TO TIANJIN ECO-CITY AND CHINA INTERNATIONAL NEW ENERGY EXPO 2009

The Singapore Business Federation (SBF), supported by International Enterprise Singapore and SingCham, is organizing a Business Mission to Beijing, Tianjin, Baoding and Wuxi from 14 – 19 September 2009, which will coincide with the **first anniversary of Sino-Singapore Tianjin Eco-city as well as the China International New Energy Expo 2009**.

The main purpose of the mission is to allow Singapore companies to explore clean, efficient and green opportunities in China, especially in the Sino-Singapore Tianjin Eco-city, in Baoding and Wuxi, and through participation in the China International New Energy Expo. Briefings by local government officials, business networking and matching sessions, site visits to local companies and other business programmes will be specially arranged for you.

China is ranked in the world's top 3 in terms of solar energy, wind energy, hydropower and CDM projects.
