

WSQ Conduct Preliminary Energy Assessment of Building Facilities

Introduction

The Singapore Workforce Skills Qualifications (WSQ) system is a national framework developed by the Singapore Workforce Development Agency (WDA) for adult workers to increase their competency and add value to the industries by taking up continuing education and training modules. WSQ caters to adult workers and aims to make skills upgrading accessible to the workforce as well as assist them in the advancement and development of their career.

SEAS is accredited by the Singapore Workforce Development Agency (WDA) to conduct WSQ modules in Energy Management.

Objective of module

On completion of the module, learners will have the:

- Knowledge and application skills in identifying major building facilities in energy audit and measurements; and
- Ability to carry out initial site assessment in developing measuring methodology and instrument checklists for data acquisition for actual installation.

Module Outline

- 1. Identify major building facilities in energy audit and measurements
 - Identify types of building's energy infrastructure
 - · Identify electricity distribution in a typical building
 - Identify types of air conditioning systems in use in energy building
 - Identify components and its application of water-cooled air conditioning system in energy building
 - Identify operations and configuration of water distribution systems in relation to energy building
 - Identify different energy consuming systems of building
 - Develop different types of energy system efficiency indexes to perform bench marking exercises
- 2. Carry out initial site assessment in client's building
 - Clarify work plan with appropriate person before going to client's building to carry out preassessment
 - Review client's building blueprints to determine locations of energy systems
 - Produce simple schematic drawing according to as-built condition
 - Carry out pre-assessment at client's building to map out actual location of measuring points for analysis
 - Perform feasibility study to determine actual location of measurement

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- 3. Prepare instrument checklists for actual site audit in client's building
 - Confirm energy audit work plan with appropriate person to make preparation for actual site installation
 - Verify accuracy of technical specifications of client's building blueprints to determine scope of energy audit works is achieved
 - Develop instrument checklists according to site installation requirements
 - Prepare audit resources for installation according to organisational procedures

INFORMATION FOR COMPANY TO TAKE NOTE

- HR Personnel of the company must ensure all the surveys conducted by SEAS are returned to SEAS at the specific date given.
- In any event that the candidate:
- a) Drop out and fail to complete the training programme or
- b) Is certified incompetent during the assessment or
- c) In any way render himself/herself unable or unsuitable to pursue the programme or
- d) Is expelled due to serious breach of discipline (including high absenteeism)
- The company will not be eligible for any funding support during the training. The company will also be liable to refund all the relevant cost incurred by WDA and by SEAS.
- The application must be accompanied by a photocopy of NRIC/Passport, and a letter from their sponsoring organization certifying their date of employment, current designation and salary.
- For trainees who are employed with the company for more than 3 months, HR would need to register on the SRP website (www.srp.org.sg) to apply for their "Absentee Payroll Funding".
- For trainees who are employed with the company for less than 3 months, they will not be eligible for Absentee Payroll Funding. Instead, the trainees will qualify for training allowance. The HR will need to get the trainee to acknowledge receipt of training allowance, and mail back to SEAS.

Cancellation

- For any withdrawal during or 2 weeks before the programme, a fee of \$250 will be charged.
