

Cambodia' first solar farm (located at Bavet City, Svay Rieng, Cambodia)

Singapore's Sunseap Group's project to build Cambodia's first large-scale solar power project under a long-term agreement with Electricité Du Cambodge (EDC).

it will have an installed capacity of 10 megawatts and be able to meet roughly a quarter of Bavet City's local energy demand, half of which is currently being met through power imports from neighboring Viet Nam. The project will also help reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 5,500 tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂) annually. In addition to providing more reliable power supply in rural areas, the project is expected to generate a range of new skilled and unskilled jobs for the local community.
