<p>1. Minutes of the Last Meeting</p> <p>Minutes of the last meeting were approved and accepted</p>	
<p>2. Update by Chairman</p> <p>Christophe Inglin, Chairman of the CE committee gave an update on the whitepaper, stating that it was well received and thanked all involved for contributing time and efforts.</p> <p>He then touched on the SolarNova project and mentioned that there were issues with the Evaluation criteria used in the HDB tendering process with them looking only at project price and not considering other factors like quality and experience of the companies tendering.</p> <p>It was suggested to have a discussion with EDB on this matter.</p>	
<p>3. Update by Secretariat</p> <p>a. Bioenergy Sub Group</p> <p>Executive Director, Kavita Gandhi (KG) mentioned the growing number of members that are involved in the BioEnergy sub-sector and suggested the set-up of a Bio-Energy Sub-Group. It was further suggested to call the first meeting in June to be chaired by Mr Edwin Khew, Managing Director, Anaergia Pte Ltd and Chairman SEAS. This group would focus on the needs of and strategic issues related to the growing Bio-energy sector.</p> <p>b. Training</p> <p>KG provided an update on the recently concluded course on 'Facilitating Private Sector Investment into Climate Change Projects in APAC' which was jointly organized by Singapore Cooperation Programme, GIZ and SEAS.</p> <p>KG mentioned the new initiative – Sustainable Laboratories program jointly organized by SEAS and ERI@N with the support of NEA.</p> <p>Update on upcoming Training courses.</p> <p>c. BD Activities</p> <p>Members were updated on the JTC – SEAS MOU, mentioning the buildings involved and SEAS role in this initiative.
